(Account may not be dormant.)
2. Application must be signed and complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Pint in ink or type your application.
4. Include the following documentation with your application:
 - a. Most current transcript (sealed). (i.e.: High school or college)
 - b. Copy of official report of S.A.T or A.C.T. Scores, unless these scores are included in official transcript.
 - c. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members.
 - d. A one or two page resume; this should include your extracurricular school activities, leadership positions, awards or honors and your involvement in community activities.
